

MORRIS TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

JANUARY 6, 2026, REORGANIZATIONAL MEETING 5:30 PM

The reorganizational meeting of the Morris Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Vice Chairman Fred Little with a salute to the flag. A roll call of members showed Fred Little, Emerson Reams, and Mark Crompton all present. Other officers in attendance were Patrick White and Patti Moore, Secretary. Solicitor Beard was absent

Temporary Chairman: Mark Crompton motioned, and Emerson Reams seconded to appoint Fred Little as temporary chair. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Temporary Secretary: Emerson Reams motioned, and Mark Crompton seconded to appoint Patti Moore as temporary secretary. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Permanent Chairman: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to appoint Mark Crompton as permanent Chairman. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Permanent Secretary/Treasurer: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to appoint Patti Moore as permanent secretary/treasurer, motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Vice Chairman: Emerson Reams motioned, and Mark Crompton seconded to appoint Fred Little as vice chairman, motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Rate of Pay Sec/Treasurer: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to approve a \$1.00 hourly increase, motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Treasurers Bond: Fred Little motioned, and Emerson Reams seconded to keep the bond at \$350,000. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Solicitor: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to retain Rodney Beard as township solicitor. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Road masters: Mark Crompton motioned, and Fred Little seconded to appoint Emerson Reams as road master. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Road Crew: (Full Time) Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to retain the FULL TIME road crew, Patrick White, Todd Walstrom and James Yedlosky. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Rate of pay/Road Crew: Fred Little motioned, and Emerson Reams seconded to approve a \$1.00 increase for all road crew members. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Supervisors Salary: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded the Supervisors salary is set at \$156.25 per month as required by the PA Township code. Effective 2026 New Supervisor salary set at \$262.08 Per month according to the PA Township Code. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

New Supervisor Insurance: Emerson Reams motioned and Fred Little seconded to approve the New Supervisor Mark Crompton be added to the Morris Township Insurance benefits. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Holidays: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to approve keeping the holidays at the number 12 including New Year's Day, Presidents Day, Good Friday, Primary Election Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, General Election Day, Thanksgiving Day, Friday after Thanksgiving, Monday following Thanksgiving (Big Game Season) and Christmas. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Holiday Bonus Pay: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to award a holiday pay bonus in the amount TBD paid in mid-December. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Vacancy Board Chairman: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to retain John Saggese Jr. as Vacancy Board Chairman. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

SEO: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to retain Wilson Fisher/Hess and Fisher as SEO. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Alternate SEO: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to retain Stanley Wallace as the alternate SEO. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Open Records Officer: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to retain Patti Moore as Open Records Officer. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Planning Commission: Emerson Reams motioned and Fred Little seconded to appoint Mark Crompton to the Morris Township Planning Commission. There is 1 vacant seat. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Auditor: 2 Vacant Seats tabled for this meeting.

Auditor: Emerson Reams motioned and Fred Little seconded to appoint Willard Verbeck to the vacant position of Auditor. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

MATOM Sewage Authority: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to appoint Josiah Jones and John Saggese to the MATOM Sewage Authority Board. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Depositories: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to reaffirm County National Bank as the depository. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Mileage Reimbursement Rate: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to keep the mileage rate at the IRS rate. \$0.725 per mile. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

State Convention Voting Delegate/Attendees: Emerson Reams motioned and Fred Little seconded to **approve** sending Fred Little, Mark Crompton and Patti Moore as delegates to the state convention. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Tax Collector/LST: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to retain Nicloe Dixon as the collector of the Real Estate /LST tax. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Real Estate Tax: Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to set the real estate tax in Morris Township at **3 Mills**. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

Certified Public Accountant (CPA): Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to retain Matthew Foster as the CPA for the 2024 Audit. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.
