

## MORRIS TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULAR MEETING

August 6, 2025, 5:30 PM

The regular meeting of the Morris Township Supervisors was called to order by Chairman, Josiah Jones with a salute to the flag.

A roll call of officers showed Josiah Jones, Fred Little, Emerson Reams, Patrick White, Rod Beard, Mark Crompton, Patti Moore.

**Minutes:** The Chairman entertained a motion, Fred Little motioned, and Emerson Reams seconded to approve the July 23, 2025, Board of Supervisors meeting minutes. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

**Financial Reports:** The Chairman entertained a motion, Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to approve the financial report. The Board also decided to close the Allport Recreation Account and transfer the remaining balance to the Morris Township Recreation Account, which will be used for all recreation needs. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

**Bills:** The Chairman entertained a motion, Emerson Reams motioned, and Fred Little seconded to approve the bills as presented. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

**Executive Session:** Emerson Reams motioned and Fred Little seconded to go into executive session at 5:33 PM for legal discussion. Fred Little motioned and Emerson Reams seconded to come out of executive session at 5:48 PM with no action. Motion Carried with all supervisors voting yes.

**Solicitors' Report:** Rob discussed briefly the executive session, stating there is litigation pending in the township and the board of supervisors authorized him to negotiate some sort of resolution with the other party but there was no formal action to take tonight.

Rod also stated he prepared a draft ordinance for the vacation of Morrisdale Dam Road. The process first is to identify the property owners and to notify them the township is intending to vacate Morrisdale Dam Road. There will be a hearing held at the September meeting, and if the supervisors decide to move forward, the ordinance can be adopted at the October meeting.

Rod also stated there will be a letter going out shortly to Rob Holland for the damage to Colorado Road while holding the road bond.

**Code Enforcement Update:** Patrick White presented the code enforcement report to the board.

**Planning Commission:** Tyler Pietroski submitted the land development plan for Jeremy Smith Storage Units. The Chairman entertained a motion, Emerson Reams motioned and Fred Little seconded to approve the Jeremy Smith Land Development. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.
