

ORDINANCE NO. 1985-5

BE IT ORDAINED, Adopted and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Morris Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance shall be known as the Morris Township Sewage Disposal System Ordinance.

SECTION 2. No person, firm or corporation shall construct install alter repair or extend an individual or a community sewage disposal system of any type, or construct, extend or alter any building of any type, or construct, extend, alter, establish, set up, or locate any type of trailer, mobile home, portable structure, to which or with which an individual or community sewage disposal system shall be used or connected, in the Township of Morris, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, until a permit has been obtained indicating that the site, plans and specifications of such proposed individual or community sewage disposal system comply with the terms and provisions of Act 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act" and the rules and regulations adopted by the department of Health of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania issued from time to time pursuant to such Act.

This Ordinance shall apply to all individuals or community sewage disposal systems hereafter installed or constructed in the Township of Morris, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, regardless of the size of the sewage system or the acreage of the parcel of land in or on which the sewage system may be installed or constructed.

SECTION 3 A fee of \$55.00 or such fee as may be designated by the Morris Township Supervisors, from time to time shall be paid to the Municipal Secretary or such other person as may be designated by the Morris Township Supervisors, when an application is made for a permit for any individual or community sewage disposal system.

SECTION 4 The Morris Township Supervisors shall adopt and do hereby adopt any forms or regulations which in their judgement may be required pursuant to this Ordinance.

SECTION 5 The Morris Township Supervisors of the Township of Morris alone or in conjunction with other municipalities shall designate a suitable person to inspect and approve individual and/or community sewage disposal systems constructed or installed in said Township of Morris.

SECTION 6 Any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine not exceeding \$300.00 or in default thereof, shall be confined in the Clearfield County Jail for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

SECTION 7 The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any portion or portions hereof shall be declared to be invalid for any reason, such decisions shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, it being the expressed intent of the said Morris Township Supervisors that all other provisions of this Ordinance would

have been adopted regardless of the inclusion of the invalid portion or portions.

SECTION 8 This Ordinance shall be construed as implementing for the Township of Morris the provisions of the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act No. 537 and the rules and regulations adopted by the Department of Health, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania issued pursuant to said Act.
