

ORDINANCE No. 2005-01-03-02
AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF WEIGHT
RESTRICTIONS ON CERTAIN TOWNSHIP ROADS IN
THE TOWNSHIP OF MORRIS

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of the Township of Morris on June 2, 1975, passed an Ordinance creating and imposing weight restrictions on certain Township roads within the Township of Morris; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisors of the Township of Morris have determined it to be prudent that the penalties created by the same Ordinance for violating those weight restrictions on certain Township roads within the Township of Morris be increased; and

WHEREAS, it is determination of the Supervisors of Morris Township that Section III of that same Ordinance shall be amended accordingly;

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Township of Morris, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION I: Section III shall be amended to read as follows:

Any person determined by a District Magistrate to be violating a provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in an amount not less than Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) and not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and that person shall also be liable for any and all costs for said proceedings. In default of the payment of the fine and costs any such offender may be sentenced to a period of imprisonment at the Clearfield County Jail for a period not exceeding ten (10) days.

SECTION II: All other provisions of said Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
