ORDINANCE NO. 2005-05-05A

AN ORDINANCE OF MORRIS TOWNSHIP, CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 97-11-24, KNOWN AS THE MORRIS TOWNSHIP AIRPORT ZONING ORDINANCE, TO PROHIBIT THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SANITARY LANDFILLS WITHIN THE GENERAL NAVIGATION HAZARD ZONE IN THE VICINITY OF THE AIRPORT RUNWAY.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP OF MORRIS, CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION III. "General Definitions" shall be amended such that Section 3.5 "Airport Hazard Area" shall contain new Section 3.5 (a) GENERAL NAVIGATION HAZARD ZONE - This zone entails a five mile radius of the airport runway. This zone begins a uniform elevation of Three Hundred and Fifty (350) feet above the established airport elevation for height limitations. For land use limitations, it begins at ground level.

SECTION III. "General Definitions" shall be modified to include new Section 3.29 SANITARY LAND FILL - a disposal site employing and engineering method of disposing of solid waste in a manner the minimizes environmental hazards by spreading, compacting to the smallest volume and applying cover material over all exposed waste at the end of each operating day.

SECTION VI. "AIRPORT ZONING REQUIREMENTS" shall be amended to include new Section 6.4 <u>LAND USE LIMITATIONS</u> - due to the danger of bird strike hazards with aircraft and similar dangers to public safety, sanitary landfills are prohibited within the general navigation hazard zone. No landfill may be developed within a five (5) mile radius of the airport runway.
