<u>Temporary Chairman:</u> James Williams motioned, and Emerson Reams seconded to appoint Josiah Jones as temporary chair. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

<u>Temporary Secretary:</u> Emerson Reams motioned, and Josiah Jones seconded to appoint Patti Moore as temporary secretary. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.

<u>Permanent Chairman:</u> James Williams motioned, and Emerson Reams seconded to appoint Josiah Jones as permanent Chairman. Motion carried with all supervisors voting yes.
