A RESOLUTION SETTING, AFFIXING, &
ADJUSTING FEES & COSTS FOR
CERTAIN TOWNSHIP SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Township of Morris, Clearfield County, is a Second Class Township and Municipality in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, organized pursuant to and in accordance with the Second Class Township Code (53 P.S. § 65101, et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Township of Morris, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, hereinafter called the “Morris” or “Township”, has previously authorized and enacted the assessment and collection of various costs, fees, and administrative charges for services provided by the Township to its residents and the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined it necessary and appropriate to adjust, from time to time, the fees authorized and collected to better reflect the administrative effort necessary for the full and fair enforcement of the various Ordinances involved; and

WHEREAS, the Township specifically determines that an increase the following fee schedule is necessary and proper and in the best interest of the Township and its residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

(1) The following fee schedule will apply to the following items as specified:

- (a) Driveway Permit: Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00);
- (b) Peddling and Soliciting Permit: Ten dollars (\$10.00) per day;
** Also requires a state-issued Driver’s License or Identification AND a background check before permit may be issued.
- (c) Junk Yard Permit: Two hundred dollars (\$200.00);
- (d) Fireworks Permit (public display): Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00);


- (e) Subdivision & Land Development (SALDO) Permit: One hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) flat fee;
- (f) Road Bonding: Forty-five dollar (\$45.00) permit fee; Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for each Authorization Form (inside truck use); and
- (g) Building Permit: Thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) flat fee.

(2) That no other fees, costs, or assessments are hereby authorized by and through this Resolution, except those specifically outlined and designated herein.


